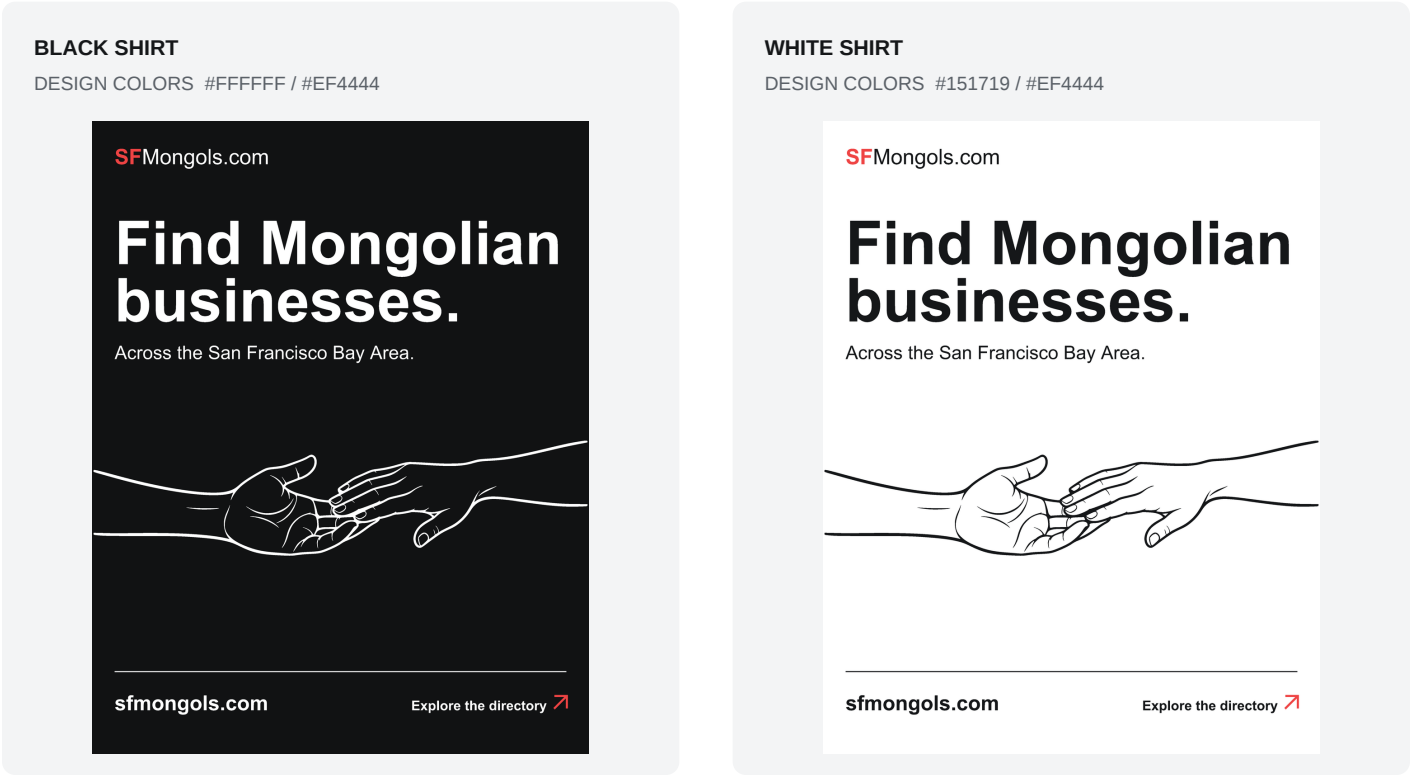


T-shirt artwork specification

Illustrated hands. Text-only wordmark. Supply the matching garment color variant.



Visual proofs only. The black and white preview backgrounds represent fabric; neither is included in the transparent print PNG.

Print method / placement	DTG or DTF / full front; separate garment color variants
Artwork canvas	11 x 14 in (279.4 x 355.6 mm)
PNG dimensions / profile	3300 x 4200 px / 300 ppi export / embedded sRGB
Transparency	Binary alpha: 0 or 255. No translucent fades.
SVG master	Lettering and hands are paths; no fonts or raster images
Visible artwork size	10.9367 x 12.5167 in on the 11 x 14 in canvas
Footer rule thickness	7 px at 300 ppi = 0.593 mm; hand tips need review

FILES TO SUPPLY

Submit the corresponding transparent PNG from **print/**, or the outlined SVG if your printer requests vector artwork. SVG lettering and hand shapes are fully outlined; no font files are required.

BLACK GARMENT

sfmongols-black-shirt-11x14in-300ppi.png

WHITE GARMENT

sfmongols-white-shirt-11x14in-300ppi.png
sfmongols-white-shirt-11x14in-outlined.svg

Production checks

Confirm the garment, process, final size and placement before the production run.

Vector master

SOLID ILLUSTRATION

SVG masters contain **outlined lettering and filled hand curves**, with no live text or embedded raster images. Each variant uses two design colors. The hands use one solid color; **no halftones are needed**. PNG exports are 300 ppi at supplied size.

1 Confirm placement on the chosen blank

Center the full-front artwork. For adult M/L, a suggested **visible-art top 3 in below the collar seam** means canvas origin **2.3867 in below it**: visible art starts 0.6133 in (184 px) inside the canvas. This is a starting suggestion, not universal. Approve the actual blank and size template. [4]

2 Use production artwork, not presentation images

Submit the transparent PNG in print/ at the agreed physical size. Do not submit this PDF, proof thumbnails or mockups as print art. Keep artwork upright and **do not mirror it manually**; leave any process mirroring to the printer.

3 Confirm white ink and underbase handling

Black shirt: use the black-shirt variant and let the printer's RIP create the required underbase; preserve opaque white details. **White shirt**: use the white-shirt variant. Printful omits white DTG ink on white garments; DTF white ink/film handling differs. Confirm the selected process. [2, 3]

4 Recheck details and approve a sample

The 0.593 mm footer rule exceeds STAHL'S 0.457 mm DTF minimum at supplied size. **Hand curves have tapered tips**; the rule measurement does not certify every hand or glyph feature. For smaller garments, scale proportionally and recheck thin details. Approve a printed sample for detail, hand feel, placement and color. [1]
